AS A PATIENT SEEKING TREATMENT WITHIN MIVC, YOU ARE ENTITLED TO THE INCLUDED RIGHTS AND RESPONSIBILITIES THAT ARE RECOGNIZED WITHIN IN OUR FACILITY.

Patient Rights:

Patients have the right to the following:

1. **Be treated with respect, consideration, and dignity**
2. **Personal privacy**
3. **Receive care in a safe setting**
4. **Be free from all forms of abuse or harassment**
5. **Be free any act of discrimination or reprisal**
6. **Voice grievances regarding treatment or care that is (or fails to be) furnished (See Grievance Policy and Procedure)**
7. **Be fully informed about treatment or procedure and the expected outcome before it is performed**
Be fully informed about their diagnosis, evaluation, treatment, and prognosis
9. **A patient representative, if patient is incompetent.**

Patient Responsibilities:

Patients must comply to the following responsibilities:

1. **Provide complete and accurate information to the best of his or her ability about his/her health, any medications, including over-the-counter products and dietary supplements, and any allergies or sensitivities**
2. **Follow the treatment plan prescribed by his/ her provider and participate in his/her care**
3. **Provide a responsible adult to transport him/her home from the facility and remain with him or her for 24 hours, if required by his/her provider**
